

Installation instructions for the Leica Q (Typ 116) - Firmware 2.0

Dear Customers,

By installing the firmware 2.0 on your Leica Q you will gain additional functions and improved performance for your camera.

Please follow these steps to install the new firmware for your Leica Q:

- 1. Switch off the camera.
- 2. Remove the battery from the camera, recharge it to 100%, and insert it back into the camera.
- 3. Download the new firmware file to your computer.
- 4. Prepare a memory card:
 - a. Make sure the card has at least 60 MB of free disk space.
 - b. It is recommended to format the card in the camera before continuing with the installation process.
- 5. Copy the firmware file to the root directory of the prepared card.
- 6. Insert the card into the camera.
- 7. Switch the camera on while keeping the video record button pressed.
- 8. Press YES to start the update process.
- 9. Wait until the update process is completed.
- 10. Switch the camera off and back on. You can now resume using your Leica Q.

Important:

<u>DO NOT</u> turn off your camera, **<u>nor</u>** remove the memory card, **<u>nor</u>** remove the battery during steps 8 and 9.
